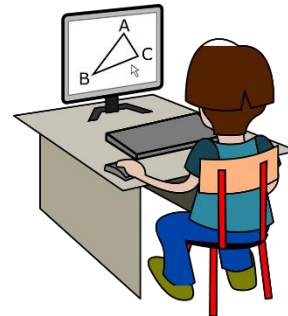

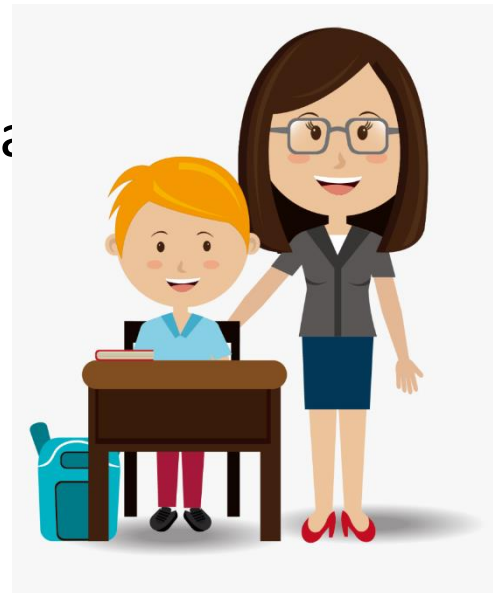

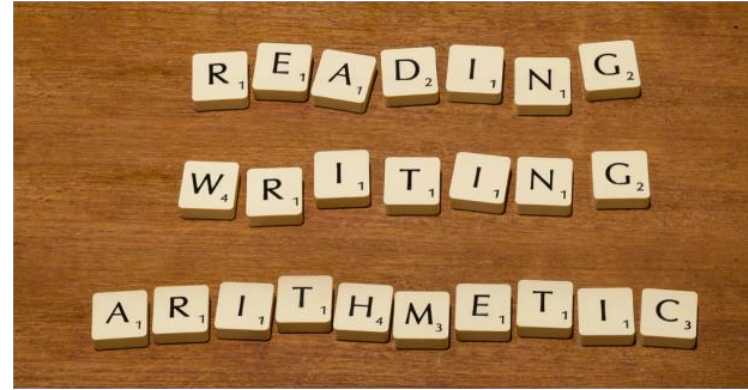

Remote Learning

- Practice is done at home using technology

- Other zoom meetings – TDA (per request)

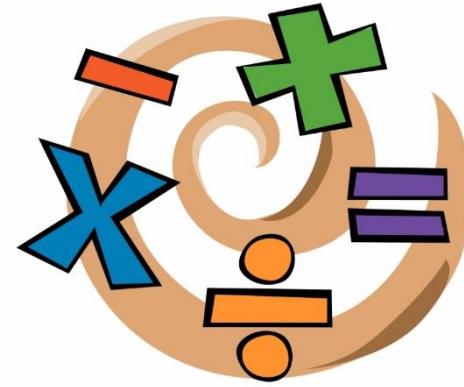


SeeSaw

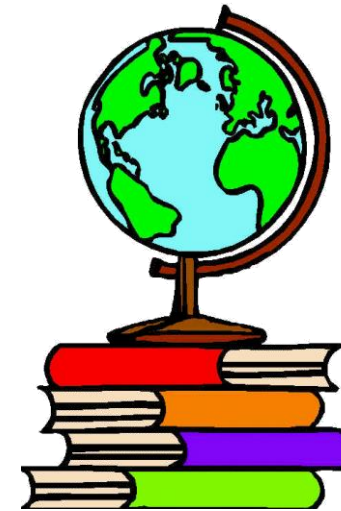
