- Students should bring a backpack to school every day. Most of their materials will remain at school. Students are permitted to take their iPads home. However, please ensure that iPads are returned to school FULLY charged. We will be using them throughout each school day.
- Please have your students bring a water bottle to school. At this time I am unsure if the water fountains will be reopened.
- CASD is requiring that all students and staff members wear a mask inside the building. Please make sure your child wears a mask to school and pack an extra in case it's needed.
- You will receive a specials schedule. Please have your child wear sneakers on PE days.
