Below is some important information regarding your children attending Crestview this year.

Class Assignments:

Teacher assignment information is available through the PowerSchool Parent portal for **all new students** and **returning students who have completed 'Returning Student' forms**. If you do not see your child's teacher assignment, it is because the child's Returning Student forms have not been completed in full.

To access your child's teacher assignment:

- 1. Logon to the PowerSchool Parent portal at https://powerschool.carlisleschools.org
- 2. Click your child's name in the top left corner of your screen.
- 3. Click the 'Forms' link/button. If you do not see that button, click the 'More...' link/button to access the 'Forms' link/button.
- 4. Scroll down to the 'Elementary' form list and click the link for 'View Your Student's Teacher Assignment Here'.

To complete the Returning Student forms:

- 1. Logon to the PowerSchool Parent portal at https://powerschool.carlisleschools.org
- 2. Click your child's name in the top left corner of your screen.
- 3. Click the 'Forms' link/button. If you do not see that button, click the 'More...' link/button.
- 4. Click the link for '2022_23 Returning Student Part 1 (Address & Internet)'.
- 5. Complete this form and click Submit.
- 6. As you complete each part, you will be taken to the next part of the form. There are five total parts to the 'Returning Student' forms.

To setup a PowerSchool Account:

Parents/Guardians of students who do not have completed 'Returning Student' forms complete, received an email yesterday from the "Carlisle Area School District" regarding PowerSchool Parent access. That information included instructions to create a PowerSchool Parent account.

Here are some important dates that I would like to bring to your attention:

August 17th- 2:00-6:00- Back to School Open House- The building will be open during this time for families to visit classrooms and tour the building. Don't forget to stop by the gym to grab your transportation tag!

August 22nd- First day of School

In the morning (Arrival):

8:20- Doors open and students will go to their classrooms. Crestview has many adults who will be ready and prepared to transition your children to their classrooms. If they are on a bus, an adult will escort them directly from the bus into the building. If they are a drop off student, adults will meet them just inside the building to take them where they need to go.

8:20-8:35- Optional breakfast in the classroom will be available for students to "grab & go".

8:35- Late bell rings-All students will need to come to the main entrance at the front of the building if they arrive after 8:35.

During the school day:

All late arrivals and early dismissals should use the main door at the front of the school. All visitors and guests should always be prepared to bring their state ID. If you need to drop off something at the school, we will have a designated "drop off area" just inside the front door. End of the school day (Dismissal):

2:45- Please communicate any transportation changes to Mrs. Roman by 2:45.

3:20- Parent pick ups will happen at the back of the school. Families will be given a tag which they will place on their review mirror and a tag for their child's backpack. You can pick up our tags at our Back to school Night.

3:20- Bus students will begin to dismiss out the front of the building. All students will have a colored bus tag identifying their bus number. Please pick up your tags at our Back to School Night.
