# TO KINDERGARTEN!

Dear kindergarten families,

As a team of four teachers, we are very excited to have your child in kindergarten at Crestview this year! We are eager to get to know you and your family. We wanted to share some information before school starts that we thought you might find helpful.

### Staggered Start/First Day of Kindergarten

Our staggered start days are Tuesday August 22<sup>nd</sup>, Wednesday, August 23<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday August 24<sup>th</sup>. Your child will be assigned to one of those staggered start days. They will only attend one day of school that week. These small groups allow your child to come to school in a small group and meet all 4 of the kindergarten teachers as well as get comfortable with their new routine.

On your child's staggered start day, we will meet you at the front doors at 9:00 am. We will give you some information about the day and then we will have you give your child their goodbye and we will enter the building to start our day. You will pick up your child at 2:00pm. There will be no bus transportation for kindergarten on these days. Your child's classroom assignment will be emailed to you on Friday, August 25th.

## Monday, August 28th

All kindergarten students will come on this day. The school day hours are 8:20am-3:20pm. Bus transportation begins for kindergarten students on this day, 8/28.











#### **School Supplies**

Please send all of the following school supplies on the first day of school:

Backpack (not "kindergarten size" - should be big enough to hold a folder, artwork, and library book)

Lunchbox (if packing lunch from home) 2-3 alue sticks

1 pack of 8 Crayola crayons (regular-sized)

2-3 yellow highlighters

1 box of tissues (to share)

Water bottle. Water bottles will come home with

your child daily to be washed and filled. Please only fill bottles with water.
