

# "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere."


This applies to our society today because when people deny justice it becomes a domino effect. Injustice effects everyone not just one person. Instead, we should encourage the domino effect of kindness.

Won the **Nobel Peace** Prize in 1964






















1944 goes to Morehouse College at the age of 15

Married Correta Scott 1953 Was on the cover of Time Magazine


Had his"I Have a Dream" speech in 1963
