		809. RECYCLING
1. F	Purpose	The Board recognizes its responsibility to promote the improvement of the environment, in compliance with local ordinances and acts of the legislature, and to educate students and employees to the benefits of recycling related to environmental improvements, reuse of resources, and fiscal savings.
2. A	Authority	The Board, in compliance with Act 101, Section 1501 of 1988, the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, shall establish a mandatory recycling program in each building in the district. The law requires materials to be separated according to high-grade office paper, aluminum, plastic, corrugated paper, and leaf waste.
		The recycling program shall include a mandatory source-separation and collection program for recyclable materials as required and provided by the contracted trash hauler.
	Delegation of Responsibility	Each building administrator shall make sure that the personnel in his/her building comply with the provisions of this policy and with any supplemental district guidelines.
		The Director of Buildings and Grounds shall establish a collection system for recyclable materials generated on district property in cooperation with the contracted trash hauler.
		Individuals or groups shall not be permitted to establish or maintain collection systems on district property without permission of the Board.
