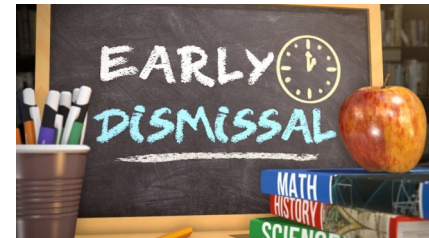

Weather Delays/Cancellations

As we approach the winter months, we remind parents that inclement weather and hazardous road conditions may result in the delay of the start of school, or cancellation of classes for the day. District officials will review the road and weather conditions and if hazardous, contact the news media, in order that a delay or cancellation notice may be broadcast by 6:00AM. We also urge parents to listen to the early morning news, as other events, heating system failures, and water main breaks, may also occur, and result in the cancellation of classes for an individual school. These announcements will be made over both local radio and television channels.

There could also be occasions where we might have to dismiss school early. At the beginning of the year, parents provided us with direction on what to do with their children in the event of an early dismissal. If that information has changed, we need to know. Also, all students in **Grade 3** need a [dental](#) exam.

All students are entitled to a free breakfast each day at school. Please talk to your child about the importance of eating breakfast each day.

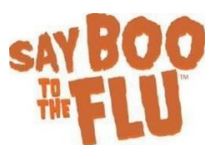
Kinsa's FLUency Program:
