- We will set up Seesaw Class on student iPads at school and you will receive an email with directions for setting up Seesaw Family on your own personal device.



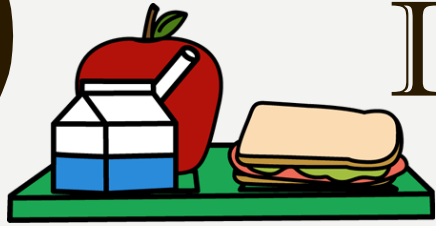
ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL



- *Arrival* begins around 9:15am, students should be in their classroom by 9:40am.
- Students will be able to get breakfast, and it will be "grab and go" on the way to class.
- Students will be sent to class as soon as they arrive.



- *Dismissal* begins around 3:15. Dismissal may take longer in the beginning of the school year, so please be patient.
- Students will receive tags on their backpacks to help ensure they go to the correct area and get on their assigned bus.
- Pick-up vehicles will also receive a tag to write their child's name to help the process go more quickly.



LUNCH AND WATER



- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom. Please pack foods that are easily opened and include utensils, napkins, etc.
- School lunch will have a limited menu this year and will be brought to the classroom by cafeteria staff.
- Water fountains will only be used to fill water bottles.
Bringing a water bottle to school is highly suggested.



COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS



- Face coverings are required for all students and should cover the nose and mouth.
- Face coverings will be worn at all times (including recess) and in all settings throughout the day, except for breakfast, lunch, and brief mask breaks as necessary.
- Upon arrival, student temperatures will be taken.
- Desks are placed six feet apart and students will maintain social distance in the building.
- Hallway movement will be limited and organized with visuals to allow for social distancing and one-way traffic.
- Hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer will occur frequently throughout the day.
- Instead of a six-day cycle, students will have the same special for 30 days.

Although the school year will look different this year, it is our goal to have *fun* while learning!
